

ORIGIN AND BREEDING HISTORY OF TASMAN

Tasman is the result of a hand pollinated cross between H818-1-3-1 (♀) and H821-1-5 (♂). Both parents were varieties owned and developed by Rogers NK Seed Co. Tasman was selected as a single plant selection in 1984. It was increased for the first time in 1986 with 20 pounds harvested. Tasman has been observed yearly since 1986 for stability. It has been determined to be stable, and free from off-types.

Tasman will become commercial in March, 1991 in the U. S. Trials of Tasman have been for testing only by the processor to determine:

1. Suitability of the product as to color, flavor, etc.
2. Sufficient yields for profitability.
3. Sufficient disease resistance for the area.
4. Suitability of Tasman for the processors needs.

NOVELTY STATEMENT

Tasman is most similar to Headliner in that both are resistant to Powdery Mildew, Pea Leafroll, and races 1, 5, and 6 of Fusarium Wilt. Tasman differs from Headliner in being more determinate, in being four days later to processing stage, and in being significantly more resistant to race 6, Fusarium Wilt.




