

COTTON PRICE STATISTICS

Spot cotton quotations for color 41, leaf 4, staple 34, mike 35-36 and 43-49, strength readings of 23.5-25.4 grams per tex, in the designated markets, averaged 67.79 cents per pound for the 1997-98 marketing year, according to the USDA, Agricultural Marketing Service, Cotton Programs. Transactions reported in the designated markets totaled 3,445,700 running bales.

Quotations for color 41, leaf grade 4, staple 34, mike 35-36 and 43-49, strength 23.5-25.4 cotton, in the designated markets averaged 67.79 cents per pound for the 1997-98 season. This was down from 71.59 cents for the 1996-97 season. Quotations averaged 71.61 cents per pound in August 1997, the first month of the marketing year. Average quotations weakened from September through January and then fluctuated the remainder of the marketing year. The lowest monthly average for the marketing year was 61.88 cents per pound in April 1998 and the highest was 74.18 in July 1998. The season's lowest daily average quotation for the base quality occurred on April 8, 1998 at 59.82 cents per pound and the season's highest daily quotation was 77.79 cents on July 8, 1998.

Prices received by farmers for upland cotton averaged 64.90 cents per pound for the first eleven months (August-June) of the 1997-98 marketing year, according to the World Agricultural Outlook Board, USDA. The National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA, reported that the average price received by farmers during the 1996-97 marketing year was 69.30 cents. The 1995-96 average price was 75.40 cents. The marketing year average price is monthly prices weighted by monthly marketings during the period August through the following July, with no allowances for unredeemed loans.

Spot cotton transactions in the designated markets totaled 3,445,700 running bales in the 1997-98 season, up from 3,224,300 bales in 1996-97, and 2,314,500 bales in 1995-96.

COTTON PRICE STATISTICS

Spot cotton quotations for color 41, leaf 4, staple 34, mike 35-36 and 43-49, strength readings of 23.5-25.4 grams per tex, in the designated markets, averaged 67.79 cents per pound for the 1997-98 marketing year, according to the USDA, Agricultural Marketing Service, Cotton Programs. Transactions reported in the designated markets totaled 3,445,700 running bales.

Quotations for color 41, leaf grade 4, staple 34, mike 35-36 and 43-49, strength 23.5-25.4 cotton, in the designated markets averaged 67.79 cents per pound for the 1997-98 season. This was down from 71.59 cents for the 1996-97 season. Quotations averaged 71.61 cents per pound in August 1997, the first month of the marketing year. Average quotations weakened from September through January and then fluctuated the remainder of the marketing year. The lowest monthly average for the marketing year was 61.88 cents per pound in April 1998 and the highest was 74.18 in July 1998. The season's lowest daily average quotation for the base quality occurred on April 8, 1998 at 59.82 cents per pound and the season's highest daily quotation was 77.79 cents on July 8, 1998.

Prices received by farmers for upland cotton averaged 64.90 cents per pound for the first eleven months (August-June) of the 1997-98 marketing year, according to the World Agricultural Outlook Board, USDA. The National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA, reported that the average price received by farmers during the 1996-97 marketing year was 69.30 cents. The 1995-96 average price was 75.40 cents. The marketing year average price is monthly prices weighted by monthly marketings during the period August through the following July, with no allowances for unredeemed loans.

Spot cotton transactions in the designated markets totaled 3,445,700 running bales in the 1997-98 season, up from 3,224,300 bales in 1996-97, and 2,314,500 bales in 1995-96.
